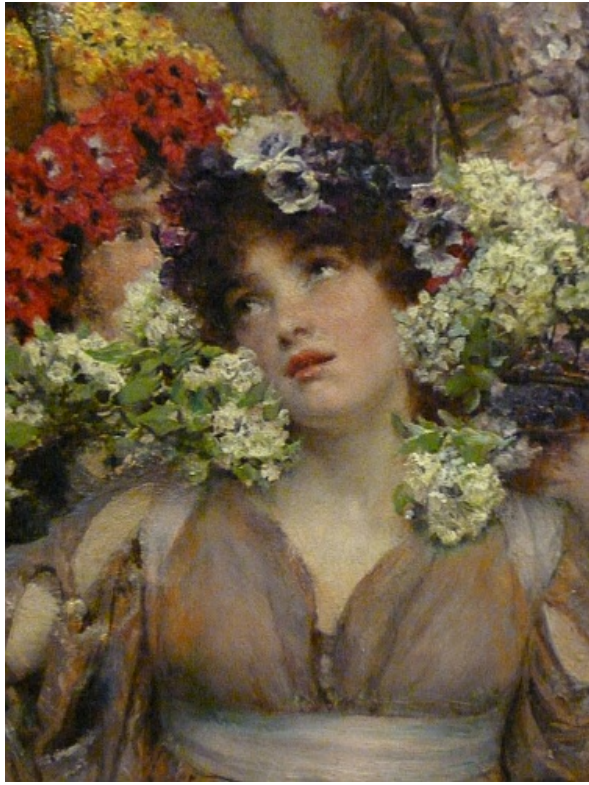


Her Point Of View (excerpt)
